



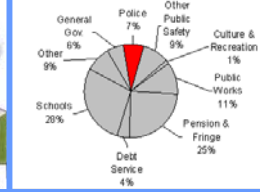

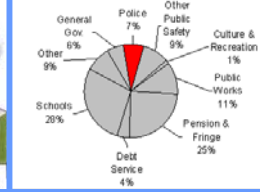




# 1. ResiStat Program Guidelines

## *ResiStat: A Work In Progress!*

- Bi-monthly meetings in each neighborhood organized by Mayor's Office staff. Goal of 20 groups city-wide.
- Meetings open to all attendees.
- Any topic of concern to that neighborhood welcome.
- Status updates on previous neighborhood questions/issues.
- City will establish email list for announcing meetings, but list may also be used by community for discussions, neighborhood activity announcements, etc.

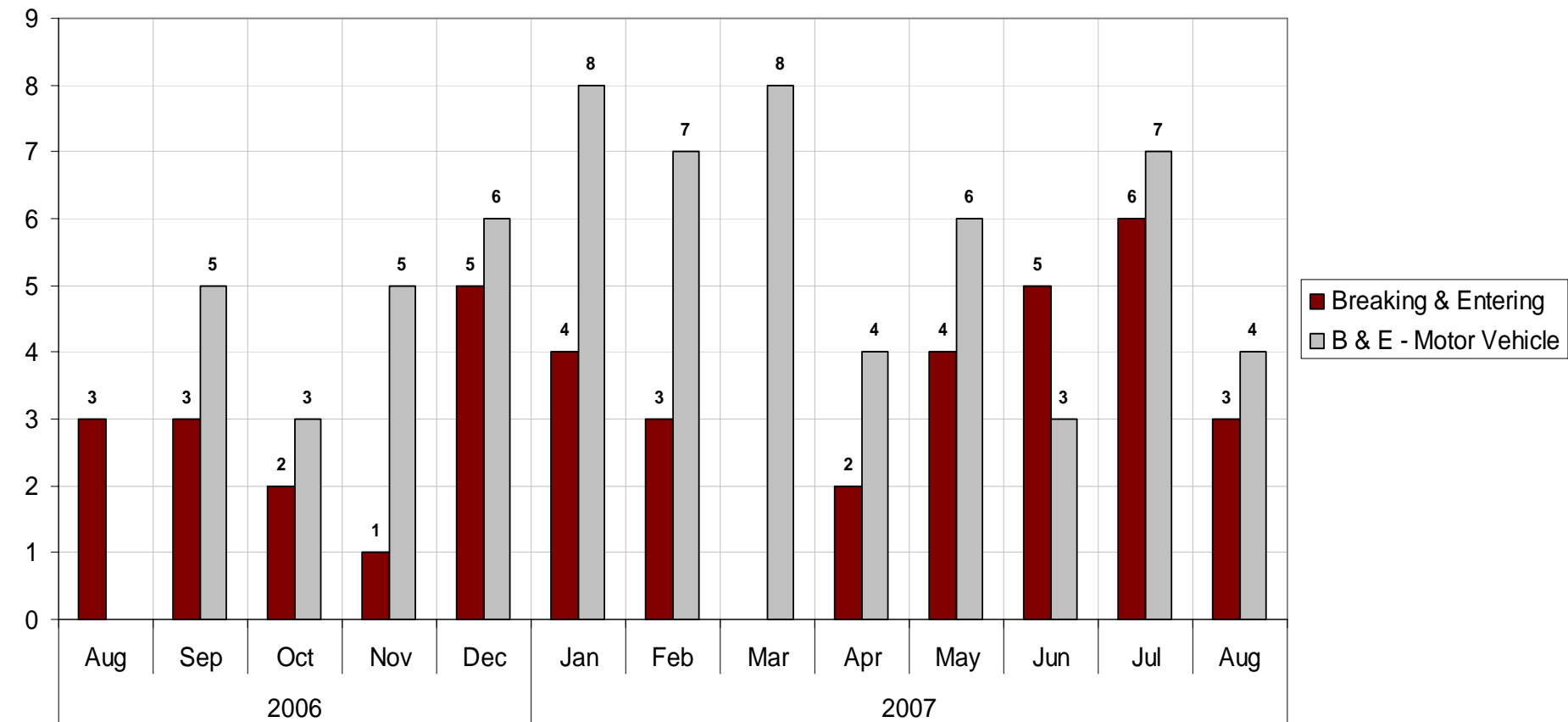

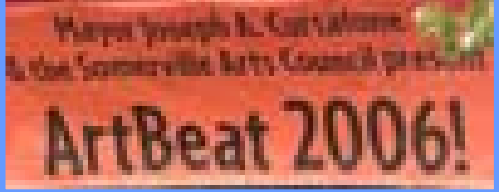
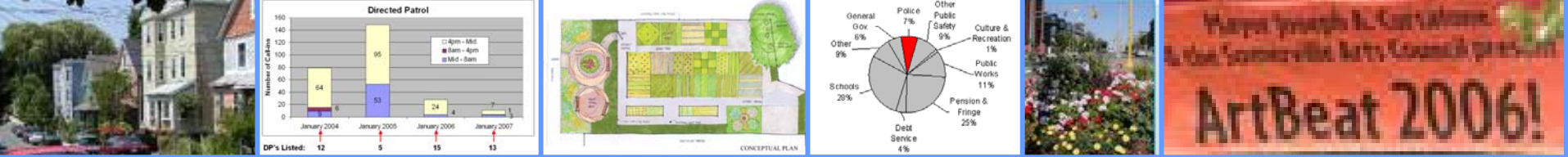




### 3. Crime Issues: Breaking and Entering Calls



*NOTE: These data represent calls reporting incidents and not necessarily verified incidents. Data is roughly within 2000 feet of One Davis Square, not including Cambridge. Geocoding data provides only approximate information on where the event occurred.*

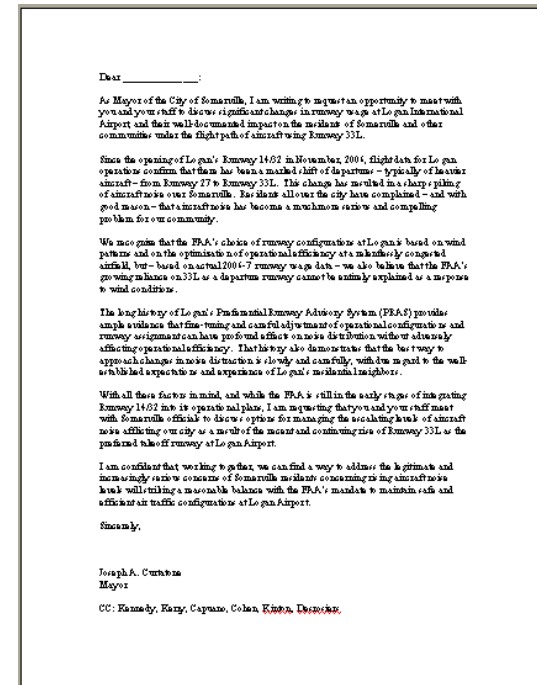


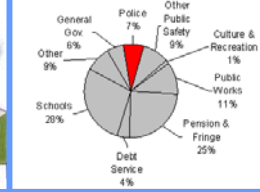
# 5. Airplane Noise

- New runway → Increased air traffic
- FAA chooses runways based on wind; but there may be other factors.
- Mayor is writing a letter to FAA requesting meeting to discuss noise.
